**“The Dawn of Orthodox Christianity in Guatemala”**

In 2010, a group of *thousands* of Guatemalans entered the Orthodox Church. What is their story? And how far has Orthodoxy advanced among them? Jesse Brandow is an Orthodox missionary who has lived in rural Guatemala for two years. He has witnessed the dawn of Orthodoxy in Guatemala, and he continues to help the Guatemalan people grow within the Church. Jesse studied at Holy Cross Seminary and graduated from St. Vladimir's Seminary with a Master of Divinity in 2013. Now, through the Orthodox Christian Mission Center (OCMC), he is serving full-time as a religious educator in Guatemala and as a Spanish-language interpreter in the two Orthodox medical clinics that have opened in Guatemala. He is visiting the United States in early 2017 to speak about Guatemala before returning to the mission field to continue this urgent work.
